"Put skid- chains on the tongue." - Anon.

Let's look at Proverbs 15 and our subject matter at hand.

I. Soft Words: 15:1

"A soft answer turneth away wrath..."

- Someone said, "speak when you're angry and you'll make the best speech you'll ever regret."
- "Use soft words, you may have to eat them..'
- "The emptier the pot, the quicker it boils."
- Remember our Lord, who when He was reviled, He reviled not again, and when He suffered, He threatened not." I Peter 2:23.
- We sing it, "I would be like Jesus."

II. Wise Words: 15:2

"The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright..."
