We lay near the covered floor grate above the oil burning stove below allowing heat to our attic rooms, straining to catch a glimpse or to make sense of the whispers in the living room below us. We always awoke earlier than our parents on Christmas morning. Gifts were stacked around a decorated tree. Mom and dad would make us wait until they finally got up and dressed. Then mom would give the gifts out one at a time to each of us nine kids. We could observe what each of us had gotten. Gifts at Christmas!

The God of the universe has a gift for us as well; and He has a wondrous tree! Let us consider both the gift and the tree...

First, let us consider God's great gift. What is it really?

Eternal Life – "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." –Romans 6:23

Living Water – "Jesus answered...If you knew the gift of God and who it is that said to you, Give me a drink, you would have asked of Him and He would have given you living water." John 4:10

Salvation – "For by grace are you saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God." –Ephesians 2:8

From God – "Every Good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, nor shadow of turning." –James 1:17

But then there are some simple facts we must recognize about gifts:

Gifts always *cost* the *giver*. –Galatians 1:4

Gifts usually focus on the *giver* and his *benevolence*. –Romans 8:32

Gifts *cannot* be paid for by the *recipient*. –Ephesians 2:9

Gifts take a sense of <u>humility</u> to <u>receive</u>. –1 Peter 5:5-6

Gifts must be <u>received</u> for them to be <u>true gifts</u>. -1 John 1:8-9

Have you received God's gift of eternal life by receiving the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Savior? God has provided a prepared place through a prepared procedure only for prepared people who have accepted His Salvation through His precious Son, Jesus Christ. Read carefully John 14:1-6 and you will find that Jesus is the ONLY way, the truth and the life! God does not have another plan to save humankind.

Second, let us consider the tree, a vital part of God's plan.

Early in the Bible, we find that a tree was the object of humankind's <u>temptation</u> and sinful desire. Partaking of the fruit of this tree was an act of

willful <u>disobedience</u> and awful <u>consequences</u>, a <u>curse</u>, and the beginning of far reaching problems for the human race. –*Genesis* 2:16-17; 3:16-19

The tree later became the object of <u>idolatry</u>, as man sought his own way to worship God his Creator. –*Jeremiah* 10:2-5

Anyone who would be hung on a tree was accursed. -Deuteronomy 21:23

But fortunately, God can do some miraculous things with a known curse: God used wood from trees to <u>save humans</u> from a world wide flood. –Genesis 6 God used a branch from a tree to make <u>bitter waters sweet</u>. –Exodus 15:25 God used trees to construct the Ark of the Covenant and the tabernacle.

-Exodus 25-26

Most Important – Our Lord and Savior <u>hung on a tree</u> (a cross) bearing a <u>curse</u> for us in our place. "Christ has redeemed us from the curse from the Law, being made a curse for us; for it is written, cursed is every one who hangs on a tree." –Galatians 3:13. "Who His own self bore our sins in His own body on a tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes you were healed." –1 Peter 2:24

God's priceless gift was not delivered <u>under</u> a tree, but <u>on</u> a tree: A Savior, Jesus the Christ. This is a treasure of infinite value, for this gift gives us the forgiveness of sins, freedom from guilt and acceptance in God's presence. Jesus, God's timeless, eternal Son stepped out of eternity in time and space to become a baby in a human neighborhood. God's Son came specifically for an hour of glory, when He would hang on a cross bearing our sin and shame. Jesus paid a great price to purchase our salvation, making us acceptable in God the Father's sight! It is a free gift! But we must recognize three things:

- 1) We <u>all</u> are <u>sinners</u>, far from God's glory. –Romans 3:23
- 2) God has provided a <u>Savior</u> to bear our <u>sins</u>, forgiving us and giving us His perfect righteousness. –2 Corinthians 5:21
- 3) But the gift must be <u>received</u> for us to have it. We must call upon Jesus, our Lord and Savior in order for the offer to be valid. –Romans 10:9-10, 13 DO receive Christ the Lord TODAY as your personal Savior!

Jean Klever's Quick Pecan Pie

- 19-inch frozen unbaked pastry shell
- 3 Eggs
- $\frac{1}{4}$ Cup Butter, melted
- 2 Cups Dark Brown Sugar
- ¹/₄ Cup Milk
- 1 Teaspoon Vanilla
- 1 Cup Pecans

Remove pastry shell from freezer. Break Eggs into a bowl; add Melted Butter, Brown Sugar, Milk and Vanilla. Beat with an electric mixer or spoon until well combined. Add Pecans. Pour into shell. Bake in 325 degree oven for 50 minutes. Cool and serve with a little scoop of Cool Whip on top. Yummy!
